In California, where many housing developments outlaw clotheslines, where drawing has been erased from the school curriculum, and where writing in full lines seems a vanishing practice even among English majors, contemplation of lines might be seen as a kind "salvage" anthropology. On the Line invokes the sensuous qualities of fabric on the line with the same nostalgia with which one might consider lost languages or civilizations. It registers my own experience of seeing a practice I took for granted while living in Europe and North Africa interpreted as a quaint survival when I moved to California. What of painting itself?










